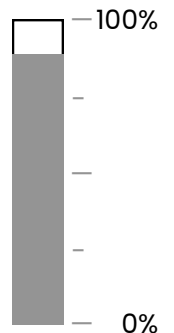

**SAINT FRANCES XAVIER
CABRINI (1850–1917)**

Virgin and Missionary

Burly longshoremen glared at the woman in widow's dress who interrupted their drinking to beg money, in broken English, for her orphanage. The bar exploded in laughter as one man responded by spitting in her face. "That was for me," the woman smiled. "Do you have anything for the children?" Given today's national debate, could it be as much God's sense of humor as God's will for our sanctification that our first "American" saint should be an

immigrant and naturalized citizen? Frances Cabrini, adopting the name "Xavier," confided to Pope Leo XIII her longing to follow her Jesuit patron to Asia. But the Pope replied, "Not East—West!" So she and her Missionary Sisters of the Sacred Heart exchanged exotic dreams of China for the impoverished reality of Italian ghettos across the United States and Central and South America. Before her death, Frances had founded seventy educational, health care, child, and family service institutions.

Today, from Siberia to Ethiopia, in sixteen countries, Mother Cabrini's sisters and lay associates embody her practical spirituality: "Let's get to work! We'll have eternity to rest!"

THE WORD IN OUR LIVES

The Dedication of the Lateran Basilica Why All the Fuss about Buildings?

I have to admit, whenever we celebrate the dedication of a church, I'm tempted to tune out and wonder—what's all the fuss about buildings? Doesn't Scripture warn us not to focus on externals, on material things and worldly riches? Aren't we supposed to care more about forming hearts and saving souls, about the Church rather than a church? Yet if the Church marks this day as a feast, there must be meaning behind it. The Archbasilica of St. John Lateran in Rome is the cathedral of the Bishop of Rome. That means St. Peter's in Vatican City, magnificent as it is, isn't the Pope's home church—his cathedra,

his bishop's seat, is at St. John Lateran. Built on land donated by Emperor Constantine, the basilica celebrates the freedom of worship granted by the Edict of Milan. So this isn't just any old church. Once a local Roman feast, it was placed on the universal calendar in 1726, reminding Catholics everywhere of the courage

of early Christians who fought for freedom of religion and the unity of the Church with the Holy See. Bringing this closer to home, today's feast can remind us to honor our own parish church. Do we treat it as a place of reverence and sacred community? Do we dress, act, and

keep silence with the awareness that we stand in the presence of Almighty God? Do we offer ourselves with Christ in the Eucharistic sacrifice, united with Catholics across the world? May we celebrate the beauty and universality of the Church today and thank God for every space dedicated to His worship. Maybe these buildings deserve more of our attention after all.

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

The Diocese of Venice is launching a "*Called By Name*" campaign, which will begin at the Sunday Masses of November 15-16. This special campaign is intended to identify young men from within the Diocese of Venice whom God could be calling to the priesthood.

It has been identified that a growing problem within the Catholic Church is a decline in the number of men coming forward to become priests. Within our own Diocese, there is certainly a great need for more men to answer the call to serve in the vineyard of the Lord as a priest. It is essential for priestly vocations to come from our own parishes and schools, and it is the task of the whole people of God--parents, teachers, clergy, and fellow parishioners--to recognize the goodness of the priesthood, and to call young men forward to say: "Here I am, send me." (Is 6:8)

It is with this in mind and heart that the faithful of the Diocese of Venice are asked to assist with this *Called By Name* campaign. Therefore, I invite all Catholics to submit the names of young men (ages 16-30) whom you believe could become good priests. Please note that it's not necessary for these young men to have already expressed a desire to become a priest. They simply need to love Christ and His Church, and to demonstrate a strong faith and a heart of service. Just as Peter received the call from Jesus through his brother Andrew (John 1:41-42) you could be the instrument that helps a young man discover God's call to the priesthood.

Following your nominations, each of these men will be congratulated on their life of faith with a letter, and they will be invited to attend a special dinner. They will also receive support and encouragement from the Vocations office of the Diocese of Venice who will also reach out to support and encourage those men identified.

Your support for this initiative is deeply appreciated, as well as your continued prayers for an increase in priestly vocations in and from the Diocese of Venice.

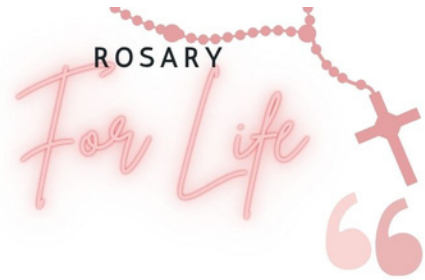

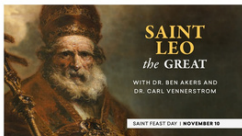
