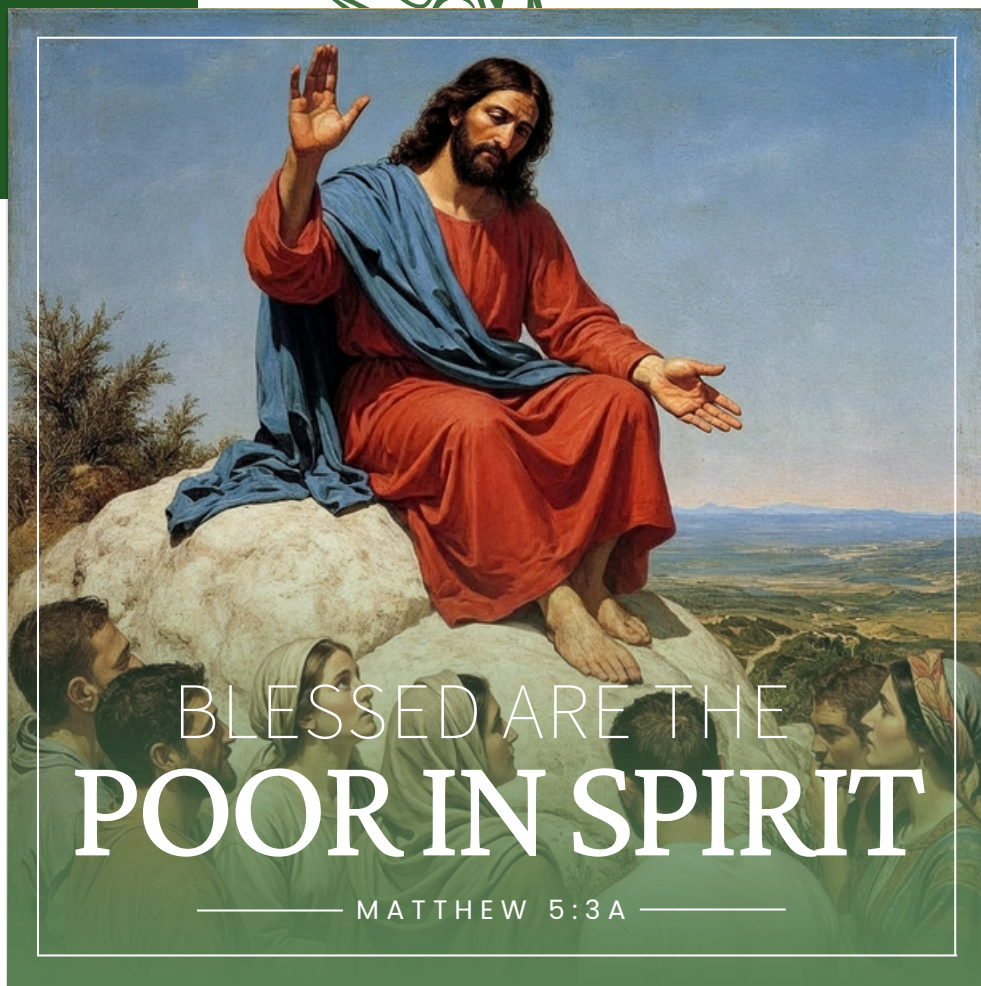

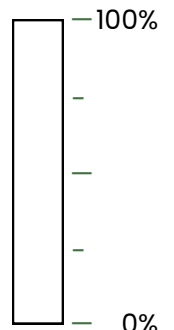

## SAINT OF THE WEEK

**FEBRUARY 5TH**

**SAINT AGATHA  
(DIED 251)**

**Virgin and Martyr**

**O**f noble birth and great beauty," so the ancient accounts describe Saint Agatha, martyred during an early persecution for refusing a powerful Roman's offer of marriage, since she had consecrated her virginity to Christ. An early preacher, Saint Methodius, reflects instead on her name, noting that, in Greek, Agatha means "good," goodness being something we can all strive for, nobly born or common, blessed with beauty—or not! So brutal were the

tortures that violated her youthful innocence, Agatha, like Agnes and several other women martyrs, was honored from time immemorial by having her name inscribed in the Roman Canon (Eucharistic Prayer I). Long invoked as protector against earthquakes—Mount Etna erupted as she was being tortured—recent attention has focused on the particularly cruel torture decreed for Agatha, the cutting off of her breasts. This has inspired cancer survivors to promote Saint Agatha as patron and

intercessor for women courageously facing breast cancer, for their families and the multitude of supporters who participate in fundraising marches and races, and, of course, for the dedicated researchers who seek a cure.

## THE WORD IN OUR LIVES

**Fourth Sunday in Ordinary Time  
Boast in the Lord**

**W**hat are you most proud of? What do you like to boast about—your achievements, your children, your work ethic? Everyone wants to be the best at something, or at least very good. But it's kind of silly to base our worth on accomplishments. What truly makes us important is that we are loved by God. That love begins at birth, long before we do anything impressive.

Our second reading reminds us that God often chooses the foolish, weak, and poor to shame those who seem wise, strong, or wealthy. Why? Because God loves the poor, weak, disabled, and homeless just as much

as the powerful and successful. In fact, the poor often love God more deeply than those with comfort and influence.

This isn't just about outward circumstances. Some wealthy people genuinely love the poor. Some of the best teachers dedicate their lives to

children with disabilities. Many skilled professionals are happiest when serving those in need. The Gospel's Beatitudes make this clear: blessed are not only the poor, but the poor in spirit; not only the hungry, but those who hunger for righteousness.

That's why Saint Paul writes, "Whoever boasts, should boast in the Lord." It's not so much what we do, but what God does through us. How much we know matters less than how well we know the Lord. Where we live matters less than whether God is living in us.

So how do we become "important" to God? Instead of asking God to bless our plans, we can ask what God wants us to do. Instead of trying to impress others with worldly knowledge, we can spend time with Scripture and quiet prayer. Instead of complaining, we can volunteer and serve. And in all the good we do, we remember to thank the Lord.

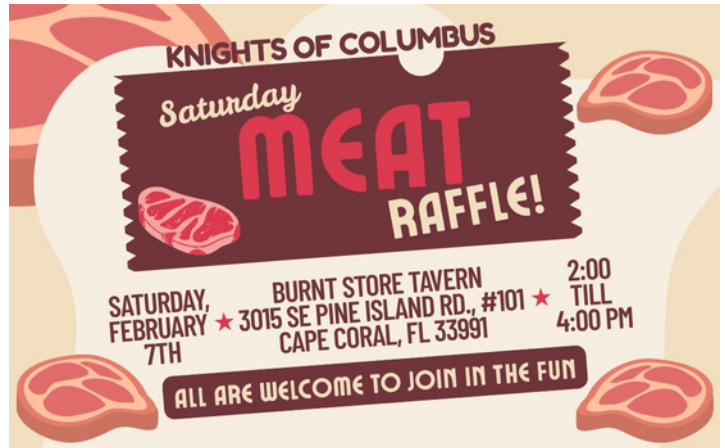
