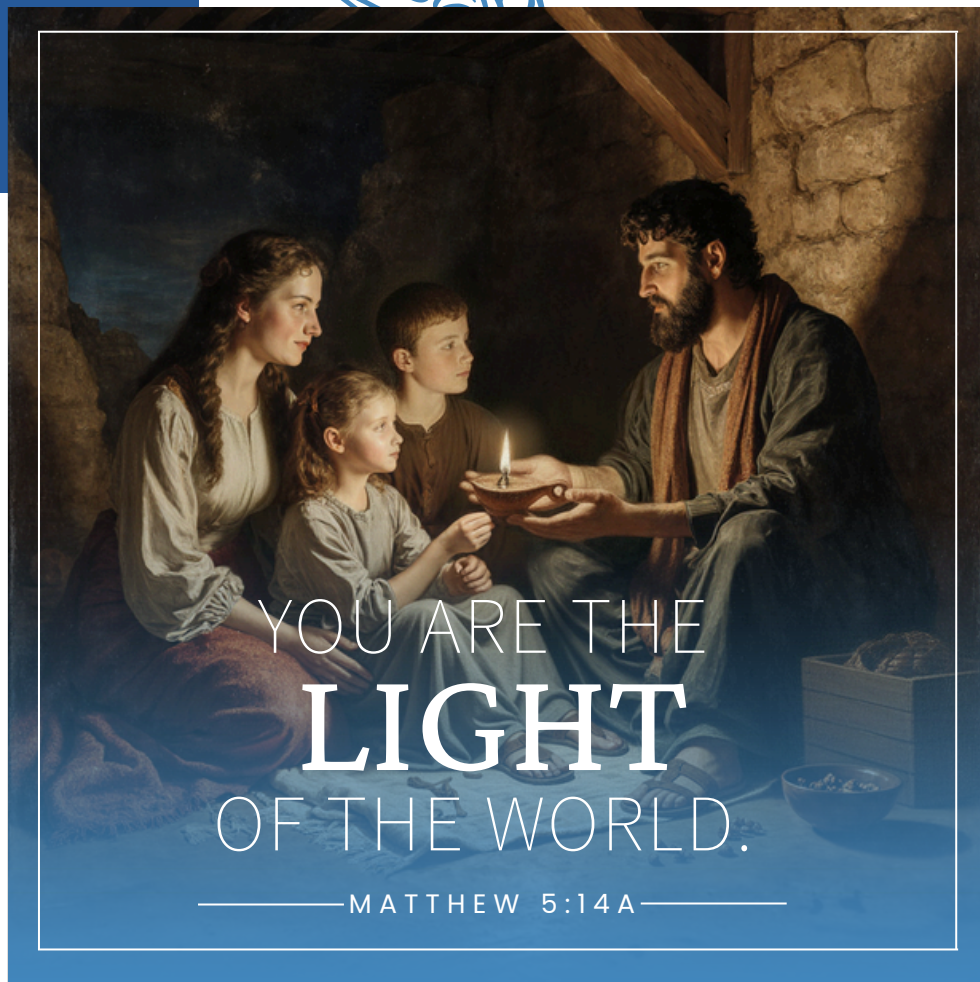

Often, those seeking to celebrate sacraments or serve as sponsors need a letter confirming parish membership. To receive one, you must be registered, attend Mass regularly, and actively support the parish through time, talent, and treasure. Using parish offertory envelopes, even if empty, helps track participation. 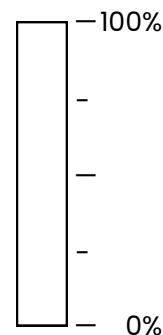

Dear SKD Families,

As we prepare to enter the holy season of Lent, I invite each of you to see these forty days as a sacred opportunity to grow more deeply as disciples of Jesus Christ. Lent is not only a time of reflection and renewal, but a season that helps us learn again what it means to follow the Lord with our whole hearts—in our homes, our parish, and our daily lives.

Discipleship begins with relationship. During Lent, the Church calls us to strengthen our relationship with Jesus through the practices of prayer, fasting, and almsgiving. These are not merely traditions, but ways of shaping our hearts so that we may listen more closely to Christ and respond more faithfully to His call.

Prayer is the foundation of discipleship. When we pray, we place ourselves before God and allow Him to form us. These sacrifices help us grow in self-discipline and remind us that our true fulfillment is found in Christ alone.

Almsgiving calls us to live our discipleship outwardly. To follow Jesus is to love as He loves—especially those who are most in need. Through generosity, service, and acts of mercy, we become witnesses of Christ's compassion and teach our children that faith is lived through love.

Throughout Lent, our parish will offer opportunities for prayer and formation, including Stations of the Cross and adult faith formation gatherings. I encourage you to take part in these moments of communal prayer and learning, as they help strengthen us as disciples walking together toward Easter.

May this Lent be a season in which our faith is not only renewed but lived more intentionally. As disciples of Christ, may we strive to reflect His love and mercy in our words, our choices, and our relationships—each and every day. I look forward to walking this Lenten journey with you, and I ask for your prayers as we prepare our hearts for the celebration of Christ's Resurrection.

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Each Lenten Season, Catholics embark on a forty-day journey, beginning on Ash Wednesday. During this Holy Season, Catholics are called to focus in an intentional way on prayer, fasting and almsgiving so as to grow in loving God and neighbor.


Each of these three Lenten pillars presents unique challenges for us. Through prayer, we consider the challenges faced by the world's most vulnerable people and how God is calling us to respond. By fasting, one is to let go of desires for material things, making room to understand more the needs of others. When alms are given, we do so with compassion toward our sisters and brothers who are in most immediate need.

Lenten alms, collected through the CRS Rice Bowl, go to alleviate hunger and poverty in communities around the world and in the United States. Seventy-five percent of gifts support CRS' international humanitarian programs, such as agriculture projects to improve crops, sanitation projects to bring clean water to communities, and education projects to provide resources and training. The other 25% of gifts remain here in the Diocese of Venice, supporting families through food pantries and soup kitchens.

Please consider picking up a Rice Bowl packet at your Parish on Ash Wednesday, February 18, 2026, or the following Sunday, and join in this simple, yet powerful Lenten practice. On behalf of those who benefit from your participation, I seek your generosity and express their gratitude, as well as my appreciation for your support and kindness.

This opportunity is taken to extend to you my continued consideration as well as my prayers throughout this Lenten Season.

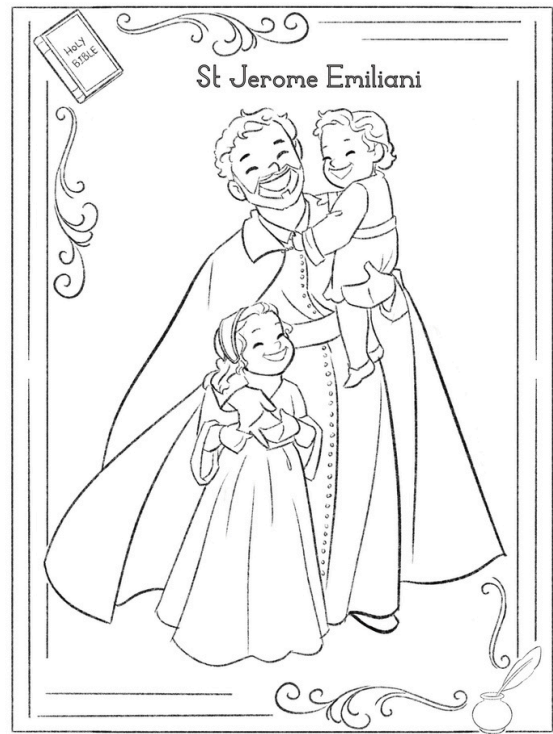
