## What is Spiritual Direction?

Spiritual direction is “help given by one Christian to another which enables that person to pay attention to God’s personal communication to him or her, to respond to this personally communicating God, to grow in intimacy with this God, and to live out the consequences of the relationship.” (William A. Barry and William J. Connolly, *The Practice of Spiritual Direction*)

**Spiritual direction focuses on religious experience.** It is concerned with a person’s actual experience of a relationship with God.

**Spiritual direction is about a relationship.** The religious experience is not isolated, nor does it consist of extraordinary events. It is what happens in an ongoing relationship between the person and God. Most often this is a relationship that is experienced in prayer.

**Spiritual direction is a relationship that is going somewhere.** God is leading the person to deeper faith and more generous service. The spiritual director asks not just “what is happening?” but “what is moving forward?”

**The real spiritual director is God.** God touches the human heart directly. The human spiritual director does not “direct” in the sense of giving advice and solving problems. Rather, the director helps a person respond to God’s invitation to a deeper relationship. Learn more by contacting:

Dear SKD Parishioners:

I am writing to share detailed information about our parish finances – both past and future.

As I shared last weekend at all the Masses, we now have a Buildings & Grounds Committee. Their purpose is to advise myself and Finance Council on the physical condition of our campus buildings and grounds and what we must do going forward to meet the most pressing needs to keep our campus in good working order.

The SKD 2023-2024 fiscal year ends June 30, 2024. The following tables present a summary of SKD operating expenses and revenue from July 2023 to March 2024.

In view of these upcoming expenses projected for the fiscal year starting July 1, 2024, the Finance Council suggests initiating a Capital Campaign to consolidate all of the above anticipated costs. A Capital Campaign will ensure that we are able to fulfill our financial obligations without needing to ask you, our parishioners, to fund each separate expenditure.

As you can see, there is much that still needs to be done. Together, with your generous support, we can move forward as a thriving Catholic community. To meet these financial needs I am asking two things of you. First, that you would increase your weekly offering by \$2.00 per week, less than \$10.00 a month. Second, if you are not currently supporting the temporal and spiritual mission of SKD, I am asking you to consider making a weekly offering.

Your offering, friends, is first and foremost a gift to the Lord. When the people were withholding their offering to God, He told the Prophet Malachi to say to the people, *“Bring the whole tithing into the storehouse, that there may be food in my house. Test me in this and see if I will not throw open the floodgates of heaven and pour out so much blessing that there will not be room enough to store it”* (Malachi 3:10).

This word from God is an invitation to us, to trust that God will throw open the floodgates of heaven and pour out so much blessing on us, that there will not be room for our lives to contain it. Who doesn’t want or need that kind of blessing from God? Do we trust God enough to test Him in this? Do I believe that God will fulfill His promise and fill us to the brim with blessings? I do, and I’m asking you to believe Him too. Why should we not give God an opportunity to bless us?

I would be remiss if I did not express my deepest gratitude for your continued financial support of the Catholic Faith Appeal. Our Catholic Faith Appeal goal for 2024 is \$241,000.00. Pledged to Date is \$181,122.00. Payments to Date total \$118,191.64 (as of April 30, 2024).

In closing, I want to thank you for your generosity, your participation in the life of our parish, and most importantly, for your prayers. Thank you for sharing all your gifts of time, talent, and treasure that build the Kingdom of God. May His glory and choicest blessings be upon you.

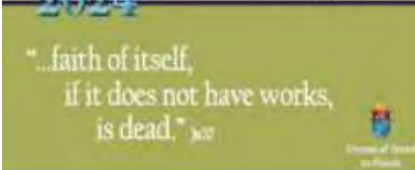
