

#### What is Spiritual Direction?

Spiritual direction is "help given by one Christian to another which enables that person to pay attention to God's personal communication to him or her, to respond to this personally communicating God, to grow in intimacy with this God, and to live out the consequences of the relationship." (William A. Barry and William J. Connolly, *The Practice of Spiritual Direction*)

Spiritual direction focuses on religious experience. It is concerned with a person's actual experience of a relationship with God.

**Spiritual direction is about a relationship.** The religious experience is not isolated, nor does it consist of extraordinary events. It is what happens in an ongoing relationship between the person and God. Most often this is a relationship that is experienced in prayer.

**Spiritual direction is a relationship that is going somewhere.** God is leading the person to deeper faith and more generous service. The spiritual director asks not just "what is happening?" but "what is moving forward?"

The real spiritual director is God. God touches the human heart directly. The human spiritual director does not "direct" in the sense of giving advice and solving problems. Rather, the director helps a person respond to God's invitation to a deeper relationship. Learn more by contacting:

Dear Father Varner,

The Lord is Risen, Alleluia! Filled with triumphant joy at the Resurrection of the Lord, I wish to extend to you my greetings, as well as my prayers for you and the Faithful of your Parish.

With this letter, I provide an update on the planned renewal and renovation of Epiphany Cathedral. As you will recall, on August 14, 2022, I wrote to you to announce the planned effort to both address structural and maintenance concerns at the Cathedral and enhance the liturgical, aesthetical, and architectural elements of the Cathedral in keeping with its role as the Mother Church of the Diocese. This plan was announced after a June 2022 consultation with the Presbyteral Council.

Tragically, Hurricane Ian struck the Diocese of Venice in early September of 2022, causing widespread destruction and devastation. No part of the Diocese was spared; Parishes and schools throughout the Diocese suffered significant damage, while Parishioners and others throughout the region suffered the loss of their homes and livelihoods. In response to that situation and recognizing the substantial cost and effort that would be required to rebuild, the Diocese announced on October 14, 2022, that the planned renovation would be postponed.

With repairs across the Diocese wrapping up and only a few projects remain, it is now possible to undertake the Epiphany Cathedral renewal and renovation project. Approval was received from the City of Venice, along with a height exemption for the planned bell tower in January, and the permitting process has been moving forward. The projected commencement for construction is June 1, 2024, and it is expected that it will take approximately two years to complete.

The total cost of the renewal and renovation is estimated to be twenty-nine million dollars. Fifty percent of this cost will be borne by the Diocese, with an additional twenty-five percent being the responsibility of Epiphany Cathedral. This being the Mother Church of the Diocese, the remaining twentyfive percent will be spread across the Parishes of the Diocese. This will be done according to a formula earlier used when contributing toward the renovation of St. Vincent de Paul Seminary which is partially owned by the Diocese of Venice. Please see enclosed the "Cathedral Commitment" form for your Parish.

Allow me to express my profound gratitude for your support in this important undertaking. Input that has already been received from Priests throughout the Diocese, including suggestions and concerns, has been invaluable. As the project truly commences, your ongoing support will be crucial, and your assistance in this regard is highly valued. Once again, thank you for your support and cooperation.

This opportunity is taken to extend to you the assurances of my continued consideration, as well as my prayers for you and your ministry. Have a Blessed Easter Season!



Dear Monsignor/Father,

Greetings in the Lord, Jesus Christ.

As you are aware, in the upcoming election Florida voters will consider an amendment that would enshrine abortion in the State Constitution. It is essential for the Church to speak with a clear and loud voice in opposition to this extreme amendment and threat to human life.

The Florida Conference of Catholic Bishops has been developing resources for this purpose, and the initial materials are provided herewith. Apart from the introductory letter, all of these texts are provided in both English and Spanish. As additional resources are completed, they will be forwarded promptly to you.

The importance of prayer, advocacy, and education on this issue cannot be overstated, and all of us must begin addressing this as soon as possible. Please remember that, though the election itself is in November, many Florida voters cast their ballots via mail or through in-person early voting at a much earlier date. This issue cannot be delayed until the fall. Thank you for your attention to this critical matter.

I take this opportunity to extend to you the assurances of my continued consideration, as well as my prayers for you and your ministry.

#### Re: Catholic Action Plan to Defeat Abortion Amendment to Florida's Constitution

Dear Pastor/Pastoral Administrator:

Many of you are already aware that a proposed constitutional amendment, which will appear on the November 2024 ballot as Amendment 4, seeks to enshrine late-term abortion in Florida's constitution at the expense of protections for preborn children and women. When confronted with such a clear threat to human life and dignity, the Church must not be silent and cannot remain on the sidelines.

To encourage faithful citizenship on the amendment, the Florida Conference of Catholic Bishops (FCCB), in collaboration with the dioceses in the state, is launching a campaign to engage and mobilize Catholics statewide to help defeat this dangerous and deceptive amendment and protect Florida's women and children from its grave consequences.

#### Every parish in Florida is asked to unite in prayer, distribute educational materials, and encourage parishioners to Vote NO on Amendment 4.

The statewide campaign is designed to assist you, your parish staff, and volunteers with running a prayerful and educational effort until voting ends on November 5. To assist your efforts, parish resources are being developed that will include:

- Statement from the Bishops of Florida released April 9 and available for placement in bulletins
- Prayer Cards we encourage parishes to pray this as a community before or after Mass; cards can be
  obtained from diocesan respect life offices
- . Educational Fiver outlines the extreme nature of the amendment and urges a 'no' vote
- Pulpit and Bulletin Announcements and Graphics to be included in bulletins until the Sunday before the election
- Prayers of the Faithful to be included each week until the election
- Video(s) will be available for showing during Masses


