

What is Spiritual Direction?

Spiritual direction is "help given by one Christian to another which enables that person to pay attention to God's personal communication to him or her, to respond to this personally communicating God, to grow in intimacy with this God, and to live out the consequences of the relationship." (William A. Barry and William J. Connolly, *The Practice of Spiritual Direction*)

Spiritual direction focuses on religious experience. It is concerned with a person's actual experience of a relationship with God.

Spiritual direction is about a relationship. The religious experience is not isolated, nor does it consist of extraordinary events. It is what happens in an ongoing relationship between the person and God. Most often this is a relationship that is experienced in prayer.

Spiritual direction is a relationship that is going somewhere. God is leading the person to deeper faith and more generous service. The spiritual director asks not just "what is happening?" but "what is moving forward?"

The real spiritual director is God. God touches the human heart directly. The human spiritual director does not "direct" in the sense of giving advice and solving problems. Rather, the director helps a person respond to God's invitation to a deeper relationship. Learn more by contacting:

FLORIDA'S PRO-ABORTION AMENDMENT EXPLAINED Why Floridians Should Vote NO on Amendment 4

Titled "Amendment to Limit Government Interference with Abortion," Amendment 4 would enshrine **UNREGULATED ABORTION** in our state constitution, making Florida one of the **MOST PRO-ABORTION** states in the nation. The amendment language is **MISLEADING**, and its proposed outcomes are **DANGEROUS**.

WHAT IT SAYS

BALLOT SUMMARY No law shall prohibit, penalize, delay, or restrict abortion

before viability

or when necessary to protect the <mark>patient's health</mark>,

as determined by the patient's <mark>healthcare provider</mark>.

This amendment does not change the Legislature's constitutional authority to require **notification** to a parent or guardian before a minor has an abortion.

WHAT IT DOES

PUTS WOMEN AT RISK

Amendment 4 would jeopardize existing laws and prohibit new ones that voters on both sides of the abortion issue support, including health and safety laws that protect women.

ALLOWS SECOND AND THIRD TRIMESTER ABORTIONS

Though not defined in the amendment, "viability" is defined in Florida law as the stage of development when the life of a fetus is sustainable outside the womb (Ch. 390.011(15)), generally accepted to be 22-24 weeks of pregnancy, or about 6 months.

CREATES A BROAD "HEALTH" LOOPHOLE

"Patient's health" is not defined in the amendment, allowing post-viability, extremely late-term abortions for treatable, temporary health concerns. Emotional health would justify an abortion when a child could survive outside the womb.

WEAKENS MEDICAL DOCTOR REQUIREMENT

"Healthcare providers" – not just physicians – could determine if an abortion is "necessary" to protect the mother's "health." Even some employees of abortion clinics, such as nurses and counselors, could approve late-term abortions.

ELIMINATES PARENTAL CONSENT

While preserving parental *notification* in our state constitution (Article X, Section 22), the amendment would invalidate the current law that requires parental *consent* for a minor to have an abortion (Ch. 390.01114(5)), making abortion the only medical decision for which parents have no say.



We are bringing them to the fountain of grace flowing from His Paschal Mystery! Don't miss the grace!







Catholic School Student Tuition Assistance

Financially, it is a sacrifice for many families and our Diocesan Schools do offer a discount to members of our parish who actively and faithfully attend Sunday Mass and support our parish financially.

In order for Father Ricky to validate your active participation here at SKD, as required on the form from the Catholic School you are choosing to attend, there is some necessary criteria for consideration for tuition assistance.

Active Parishioner Status includes:

- •Being formally registered and participating at the parish for at least three months.
- •Faithful attendance to Mass on Sundays and Holy Days of Obligation.
- •Support the Parish by using the Sunday envelopes or online giving.
- •Involvement in at least one ministry or organization in the Parish.

The monetary sacrifice is insignificant as much as your family participation in attending Sunday Mass each week. Consideration for the school discount depends online giving or using the Sunday Envelopes to show participation in the Sunday Mass. Some school families give online supporting the parish. However, school families who choose to financially support the parish by using the Sunday Envelope need to do so each week by placing it in the basket, if you are applying for the school discount.
