



What is Spiritual Direction?

Spiritual direction is "help given by one Christian to another which enables that person to pay attention to God's personal communication to him or her, to respond to this personally communicating God, to grow in intimacy with this God, and to live out the consequences of the relationship." (William A. Barry and William J. Connolly, *The Practice of Spiritual Direction*)

Spiritual direction focuses on religious experience. It is concerned with a person's actual experience of a relationship with God.

Spiritual direction is about a relationship. The religious experience is not isolated, nor does it consist of extraordinary events. It is what happens in an ongoing relationship between the person and God. Most often this is a relationship that is experienced in prayer.

Spiritual direction is a relationship that is going somewhere. God is leading the person to deeper faith and more generous service. The spiritual director asks not just "what is happening?" but "what is moving forward?"

The real spiritual director is God. God touches the human heart directly. The human spiritual director does not "direct" in the sense of giving advice and solving problems. Rather, the director helps a person respond to God's invitation to a deeper relationship. Learn more by contacting:

2:"The Choir and Cantor" "Mirror, mirror on the wall..." We've all looked into a mirror at some-point in our life time and hopefully the reflection makes one happy, proud and even confident of the image standing infront the mirror.

That's how I "see" the role of a Church Cantor or Choir... A "reflection" of the praying assembly. The primary ministry of choir or cantor is to "reflect and return vocal support" of the singing Assembly.

In the early days of the church, especially in Europe, it was the role of the "boy choirs" to perform the intricate music of the Mass because of its' musical difficulty and the entire Mass was in Latin.

After Vatican II, and the Church opened its' doors to R praying the Mass in the vernacular (the language of the 2 people and the country they live in) the role of the choir/cantor shifted significantly and its' primary function was to lend vocal support of the praying Assembly. Today, as even here at SKD, you will "see" the cantor or choir no longer located in a choir loft away from the assembly. They are physically located in the nave of the Church, in a place dedicated for their ministry but within the praying assembly.

A choir/cantor is primarily there to lead and support the assembly but there are opportunities within the Mass for the Music Ministry to provide "choral selections" for the assembly to "reflect" in quiet prayer.

The times during the Mass appropriate for such presentations of church choral music where a Cantor/ Choir may sing something alone would be as Prelude Music, as the Church is gathering before Mass.

The only time appropriate within the Mass for a choral piece to be presented for the assembly to quietly reflect on would be during the Presentation of Gifts. (Where actually within the (GIRM) General Instruction of the Roman Missal doesn't indicate something must be sung by anyone at all.)

A choir also helps bring polyphony (harmonies) to the music being sung by the Assembly. It is a way to augsung by all. Cantors/Choirs come in all ages and styles. Here at SKD we a blest with many parishioners who have dedicated their time and talent in helping to bring the black of the black beauty to the Music of the Mass. They are members of our Bell Choir, Cantors, Children's Choir, Contemporary Choir and Traditional Choir. (Over 90 individuals!)

Outside of Mass, they will share their talents this year in offering a Sacred Christmas Concert, "Christmas In Song," on Friday, December 6 @7pm and a Sacred Holy Week Concert, "Moses The Burning Within," on

Friday, April 11 @7pm. These concerts are presented for YOU in "prayer-formance" to deepen our celebration of our Holy Days in the Catholic Church.






ROSARY RALLY




