

What is Spiritual Direction?

Spiritual direction is "help given by one Christian to another which enables that person to pay attention to God's personal communication to him or her, to respond to this personally communicating God, to grow in intimacy with this God, and to live out the consequences of the relationship." (William A. Barry and William J. Connolly, *The Practice of Spiritual Direction*)

Spiritual direction focuses on religious experience. It is concerned with a person's actual experience of a relationship with God.

Spiritual direction is about a relationship. The religious experience is not isolated, nor does it consist of extraordinary events. It is what happens in an ongoing relationship between the person and God. Most often this is a relationship that is experienced in prayer.

Spiritual direction is a relationship that is going somewhere. God is leading the person to deeper faith and more generous service. The spiritual director asks not just "what is happening?" but "what is moving forward?"

The real spiritual director is God. God touches the human heart directly. The human spiritual director does not "direct" in the sense of giving advice and solving problems. Rather, the director helps a person respond to God's invitation to a deeper relationship. Learn more by contacting:





"The Director of Music"

I was blest to have attended catholic schools from kindergarten through high school and my parents made sure we went to 8am Mass every Sunday as a family. (Although my brother and I were never allowed to sit next to one another because we sometimes didn't behave!)

As a youngster, I must admit sometimes I didn't understand everything that was happening during the Mass. Looking back and remembering as a small child I was probably bored often because 🕻 the Mass was too "wordy" and too "adult" for me. The part of the Mass that drew me in as a child was the Music. I loved listening to all the instruments, the organ, the guitars, the flutes and more. AND, I loved hearing everyone around me sing. (Even my Dad, to whom this day the key he sang in has YET to be identified in the music world.)
I attribute my earliest prayers to singing in the Mass because it 🖁 made me feel a part of the praying community. That was thanks to 🖁 Sr. Kathy Andrews, a Pastoral Associate who invited me to sing with the "Guitar Group" for Sunday 12nn Mass when I was only in **third** grade. She taught me the beginning of playing a guitar and was very instrumental in passing on many wonderful attributes and ide- 🕻 als of what the role of Music Director was in the Church.

She taught to make sure the choir was well prepared, the instruments were tuned and most importantly always keep in mind the role of the Assembly and how important it was to engage and invite them in participating in the sung prayers of the Mass through my

musicianship.

The music of the Church has always held a special place in my heart. The role of Music Director is in many ways more of a vocable and the companion of the comp 🖁 tion than a job. I have had the opportunity to serve in this capacity 🖁 🖁 at three churches in my lifetime and with each community I have 🖁 learned, I have grown, I have prayed, and hopefully lived up to the Frole of Music Director in preparing the choirs well to lead, tuning 🖁 instruments and all the other "behind the scenes" tasks that the role 🖁 🖁 requires especially mindful of actively engaging and inviting the 🖁 faithful in the pews to sing the Mass.

The hardest part of being a Music Director is knowing that not everyone is going to like every song that is selected. Over 35 years I too have struggled with a song or two I don't particularly care for, BUT, when one of those songs does come into rotation I try to put myself back in time and play it like it was the very first time I ever heard the piece and remember the prayerful beauty of the lyrics and how much the music enhanced the Mass. I also realize that not everyone likes every instrument and that is why as a Music Director I try to offer various styles and instruments each week at Mass.

In the end, I could never see myself not being involved in the Music 🕻 Ministry of the Catholic Church. I know when the time comes for me to retire, I will still want to be involved in the music of God's Church. He placed that love in my heart and I will forever praise Him for that!







