A Parliamentary Minute... Changing our Minds

So, a motion was made, a vote taken, and it was approved. What if later you see that this was not the best way of doing it. Are we allowed to change our minds? Yes!!! But you guessed it, there is a procedure for that. 1 - A member who voted for the winning side

can make a motion to **reconsider**. **2** - The motion to reconsider must be made on the same day and only if the original motion is made in a regular meeting; i.e., if membership voted for it. 3 - The correct language is: "I move to reconsider the vote on the motion (describe); I voted for the motion." 4 - If the motion to reconsider is adopted, then the original motion goes back before the assembly. 5 - The motion to rescind or amend a previously adopted motion: If the motion was not previously advertised, a 2/3 vote or a majority of the entire membership is needed to adopt. Telling membership ahead of time ensures they will be there for the vote if interested. 6 - And yes, there can be a motion made on this again, only at the next meeting.
