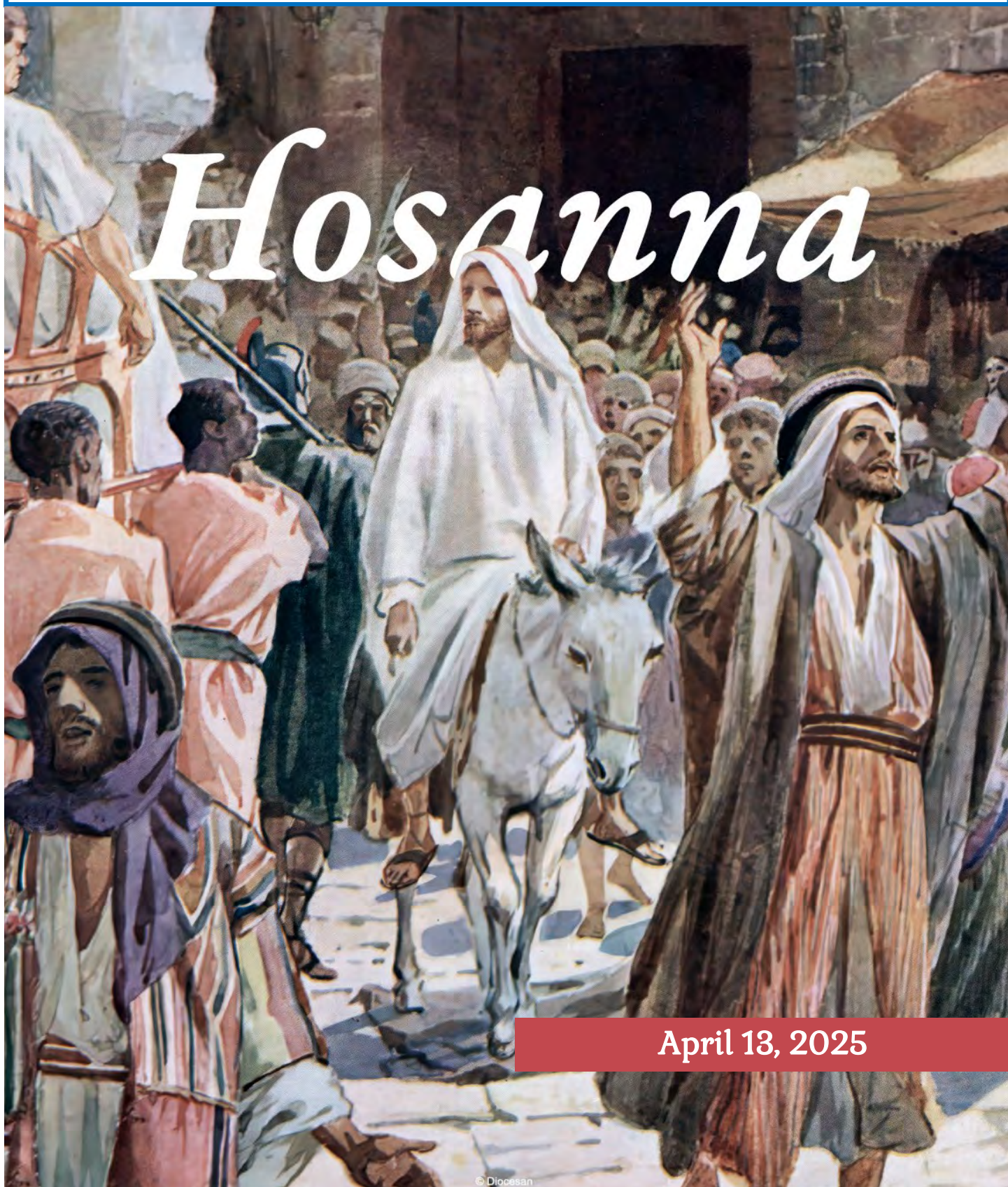

HOLY WEEK



PALM SUNDAY

This is the Sunday when the Holy Week begins. Traditionally, Palm Sunday commemorates the Triumphal entry of Jesus into Jerusalem described in all four canonical gospels. It is also called Passion Sunday.

HOLY MONDAY TO SPY WEDNESDAY



MAUNDY THURSDAY

Also called Thursday of Holy Week. The day when the Last Supper is commemorated.

GOOD FRIDAY

Good Friday commemorates the crucifixion of Jesus and his subsequent death. The cross is the symbol of this day.



HOLY SATURDAY

Also called Black Saturday. Holy Saturday is the day between the crucifixion of Jesus and his resurrection.

EASTER SUNDAY

Easter Sunday is the great feast day and apogee of the Christian liturgical year; on this day the Resurrection of Jesus Christ is celebrated. It is followed by the Easter week.

Dear Parish Families: As your pastor, I often find myself reflecting on what a great blessing it is to walk this journey of faith with you. Each week, I see the fruit of your devotion and the love you pour into the life of our parish. Today, I'd like to take a moment to do something a little different—something that comes from a deep place in my heart. I want to express my sincere gratitude for all of you who support the vision and mission of our parish family here at SKD.

Last week, I received some feedback that there are concerns among a few of you regarding the idea that I have favorites in the parish. There is a perception that certain individuals or groups are influencing how the parish is run, and I'd like to take a moment to clarify any misunderstandings.

Yes, I do have favorites. But perhaps not in the way you might think. As your pastor, I value so many of you who support our parish's vision and mission, and today, I want to share with you who my favorites are. They are not individuals who pull strings behind the scenes or tell me how to lead the parish. They are those who are here, week in and week out, giving of themselves for the greater good of our faith community.

My favorites are the dedicated people you see every Sunday—those who serve in our ministries. They are our sacristans, lectors, Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion, Parish money counters, hospitality members, altar servers, and all those involved in our apostolates: Pro-Life Commission, the Knights of Columbus, Ladies Auxiliary, Council of Catholic Women, Legion of Mary, and our Prayer teams. Their work, gifts, and commitment impact my work as your pastor in ways that I can never fully express.

I also consider my favorites those who help keep our parish functioning day-to-day: our parish administration—our business manager, director of Religious Education, administrative assistants, receptionist/media editor, director of youth, and those who care for our physical space, including housekeeping and maintenance. Without them, much of what we do would not be possible.

In addition, my favorites include the members of the Jeremiah Team and Finance Council, who meet regularly with me to ensure that we remain true to our mission, that we are on a path to reach our long-term vision, and that we are good stewards of the resources entrusted to us. Their dedication and wisdom guide us toward a prosperous and faithful future.

Lastly, my favorites are the families of our parish who are deeply committed to living out their vocation in life. They strive to embody the pillars of prayer, learning, and service that are central to our mission, inspired by the example of Saint Katharine Drexel. These families are the heart of our parish, and their efforts are the foundation upon which we build our faith community.

In light of all this, I want to express my heartfelt gratitude. To all of you who give so generously of your time, talent, and treasure, I say thank you. I see your efforts, I recognize your sacrifices, and I appreciate your faith and your prayers. I carry each of you in my prayers, as we work together to build the Kingdom of God—one act of love, one ministry, and one shared vision at a time.

Through these scriptures, I see reflected the lives of so many of you who lead by example—who put others first, who humble yourselves for the good of the parish, and who work tirelessly in service to Christ. You are my favorites because you embody the spirit of Christ's self-giving love.

Today, I thank you. I deeply value each one of you. Your efforts, your prayers, your sacrifices—none of them go unnoticed. And together, let us continue to make our parish a place where Christ is known, loved, and served—by all and through all.

May God bless you all as we embrace this Holy Week journey together, building His Kingdom, one step at a time.

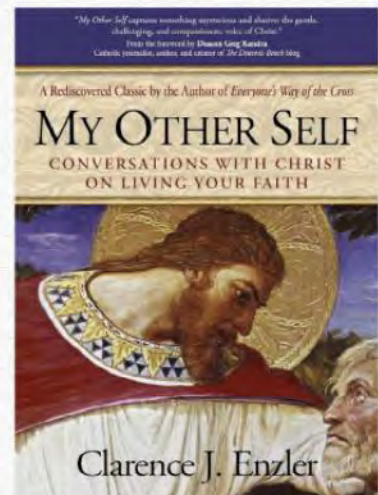

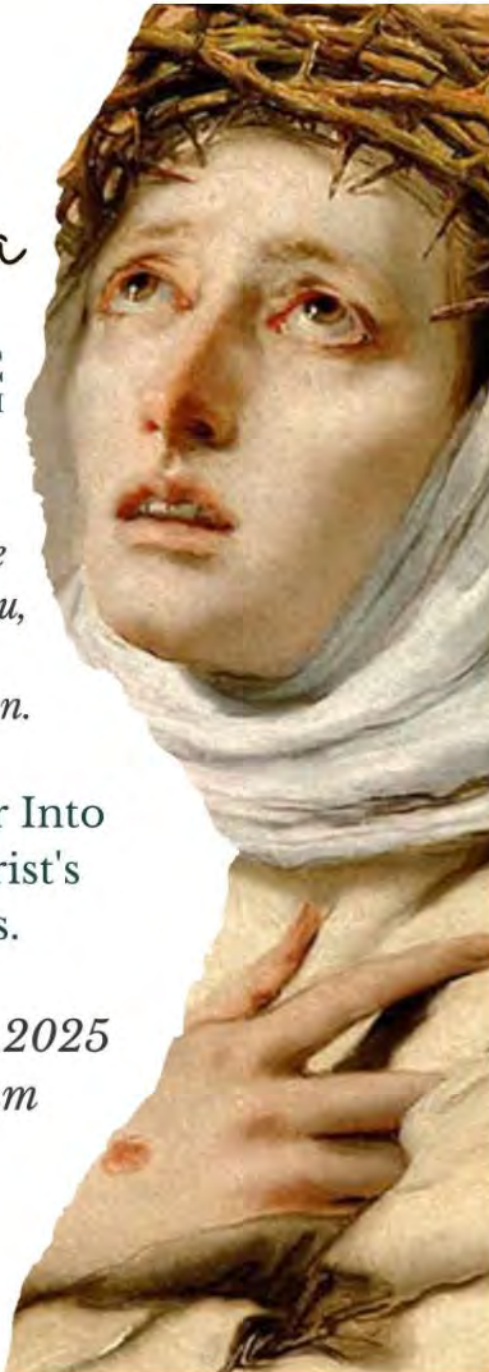
