



## What is Spiritual Direction?

Spiritual direction is "help given by one Christian to another which enables that person to pay attention to God's personal communication to him or her, to respond to this personally communicating God, to grow in intimacy with this God, and to live out the consequences of the relationship." (William A. Barry and William J. Connolly, *The Practice of Spiritual Direction*)

Spiritual direction focuses on religious experience. It is concerned with a person's actual experience of a relationship with God.

**Spiritual direction is about a relationship.** The religious experience is not isolated, nor does it consist of extraordinary events. It is what happens in an ongoing relationship between the person and God. Most often this is a relationship that is experienced in prayer.

**Spiritual direction is a relationship that is going somewhere.** God is leading the person to deeper faith and more generous service. The spiritual director asks not just "what is happening?" but "what is moving forward?"

The real spiritual director is God. God touches the human heart directly. The human spiritual director does not "direct" in the sense of giving advice and solving problems. Rather, the director helps a person respond to God's invitation to a deeper relationship. Learn more by contacting:



## THE WORD IN OUR LIVES:

## BE CAREFUL WHAT YOU ASK FOR

Jesus encourages us to pray with faith and confidence, but then adds, "How much more will the Father give the Holy Spirit to those who ask him?" (Luke 11:13). Does this mean there are limits to what we can ask for? Not exactly—but it does shift our focus. While we often pray for things we believe are good, Jesus is teaching two key lessons about prayer.

First, God hears and answers every prayer, but not always in the way we expect. "Ask and you shall receive" doesn't mean God grants every request. Rather, He gives what is truly best for us—even if that means saying no. So perhaps our first prayer should be for the wisdom to know what we truly need.

Second, prayer changes us more than it changes God. True prayer echoes Jesus' own words: "Not as I will, but as you will" (Matthew 26:39). That kind of transformation—from self-centered desires to holy ones—requires the Holy Spirit's power. The Spirit, who raised Jesus from the dead, empowers us to align our hearts with God's will. In promising the Spirit, Jesus assures us that God not only hears us but gives us the strength to desire what truly matters.




## **GOD ANSWERS OUR CALL FOR HELP**

Several months ago, our pastor asked my husband and me to mentor engaged couples. I smiled at the timing—it echoed my parents' ministry, especially my dad's as a permanent deacon. Their marriage wasn't perfect, but their commitment gave me hope that our own ups and downs might serve as a witness. Rather than disqualify us, our struggles might help others see what fidelity really looks like.

When we met with our first couple, my husband was just weeks away from back surgery. His recovery involved pain, immobility, and a lot of caregiving—from bathing and dressing to simply offering encouragement. I was reminded of the vows we took "in good times and in bad," and of Christ's words—He never promised ease, only His presence to help us carry the load.

Today's readings echo that promise. From God's mercy on Sodom, to Paul's reminder of forgiveness, to Jesus' assurance that those who seek will find—Scripture is clear: God responds when we call. Whether we're walking through the challenges of marriage, illness, or sin, we're never alone. As today's Psalm declares, "Lord, on the day I called for help, you answered me."







## JULY 29

## SAINT MARTHA (FIRST CENTURY)

Whether you find Martha Stewart admirable or annoying, she has the perfect patron saint. Luke describes Martha—saint, not Stewart—as "burdened with much serving" (Luke 10:40). About Mary, seated, listening to Jesus, Martha complained, "Do you not care that my sister has left me by myself to do the serving?" Jesus' response, "Martha, Martha, you are anxious and worried about many things... Mary has chosen the better

part" (10:41, 42), suggests to some the both/and. Jesus ministered in prayersuperiority of the contemplative life, leaving the rest of us, supporting families, earning livings, (helping others?), as "second-class" Christians. But Luke introduces Martha and Mary immediately after Jesus' parable of the Good Samaritan, whom Jesus recommends as a model of practical compassion, concluding, "Go and do likewise" (10:37). Go and do! Sit and listen! Discipleship is never either/or but

ful silence and hospitable service. Monastic calendars add Martha's sister Mary and brother Lazarus, calling all three "hosts of the Lord," recalling their welcome of Jesus to their home in Bethany, reminding us Whom we welcome whenever we extend summertime hospitality!




