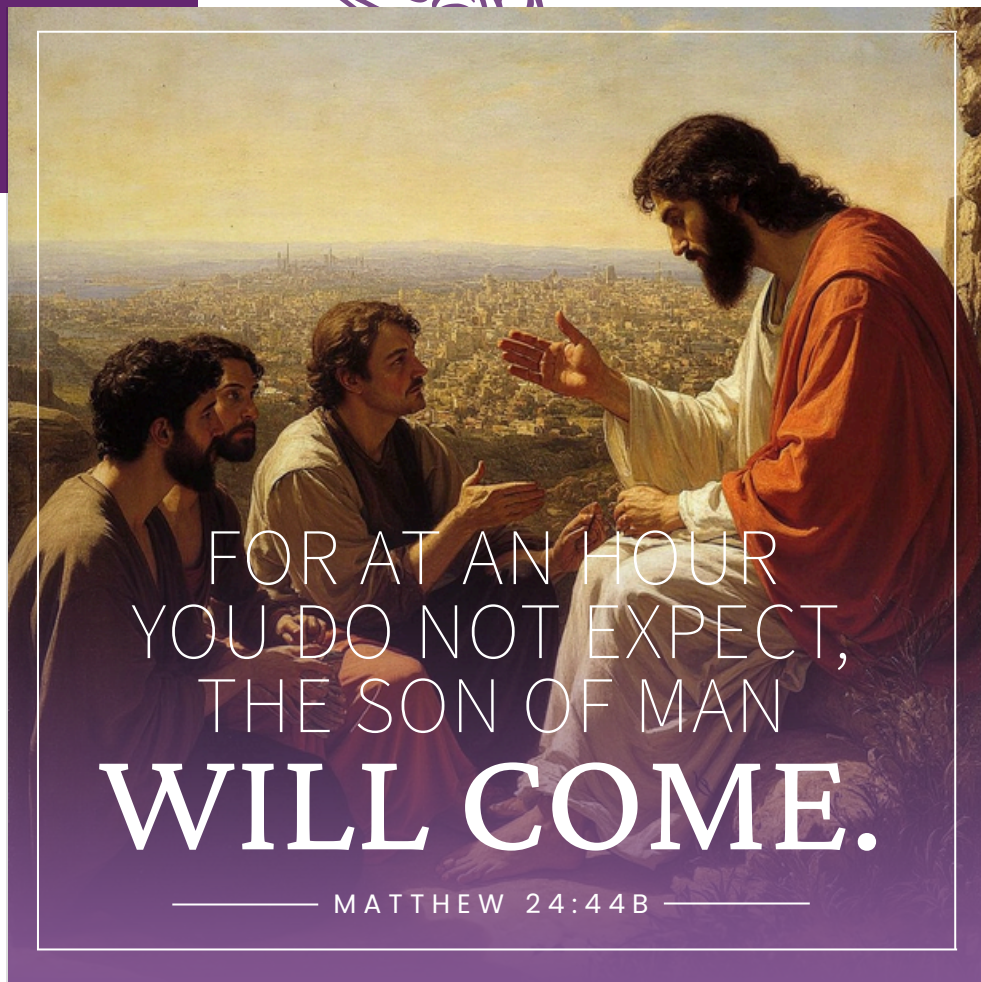

If you're new to our parish or have been attending Mass without registering, we kindly ask you to register to help us stay organized and plan for future needs. If you haven't received a welcome letter, please call the parish office to confirm your registration.

Registering at Saint Katharine Drexel expresses your commitment to our Catholic community.

Often, those seeking to celebrate sacraments or serve as sponsors need a letter confirming parish membership. To receive one, you must be registered, attend Mass regularly, and actively support the parish through time, talent, and treasure. Using parish offertory envelopes, even if empty, helps track participation. 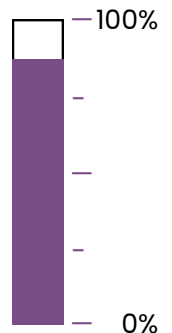

Dear Parishioners and Friends,

Each year during Advent, the Church traditionally invites us to meditate on the "*Four Last Things*"—Death, Judgment, Heaven, and Hell. Yet, as we stand once again on the threshold of a new liturgical year, I'd like to turn our gaze toward what I call the "*Four First Things*." Advent is, after all, a season of fresh beginnings—a time to be awake, watchful, and ready for God's surprises.

The first of these "*First Things*" is God Himself, the very source of our being. When the Lord spoke to Moses from the burning bush, He revealed His divine name: "*I AM*." In this revelation, we learn that God is not simply the creator of life—He is life. God is not one who merely exists; rather, He is existence itself. Everything that is good, true, and beautiful flows from His being.

The second "*First Thing*" we might reflect upon this Advent is Light. Scripture tells us that the very first act of creation was this command: "*Let there be light*." Some have mocked the story, pointing out that the sun, moon, and stars were not made until the fourth day. But this light—this primordial radiance—is not the light of celestial bodies. It is the Light that comes from God Himself, the Light that no darkness can overcome.

This divine Light is revealed fully in Jesus Christ, the Word made flesh. As John's Gospel proclaims, "*The true Light, which enlightens everyone, was coming into the world*." Advent is our season of longing for that Light—of preparing our hearts for Christ, the Light of the World.

And yet, as we wait and watch, Advent is not a passive season. It is a call to active discipleship. In this holy time, we are invited to rekindle the spiritual gifts God has given us and to live as intentional disciples—those who choose to follow Christ with purpose, devotion, and love.

Here we can turn to the example of **Saint Katharine Drexel**, whose life was built upon three enduring pillars: **Prayer, Learning, and Service**. These are not separate virtues, but three lights that reflect the one Light of Christ.

- **Prayer** keeps our hearts attuned to God's presence—the same presence that once spoke from the burning bush and still speaks in the quiet of our souls. During this Advent, let us deepen our prayer life, allowing God's light to illumine the hidden corners of our hearts.
- **Learning** helps us grow in the knowledge of our faith, so that our minds, too, may be enlightened by the truth of Christ. Like Saint Katharine, may we seek to understand the mysteries we celebrate, letting the Word of God shape our thoughts and actions.
- **Service** is the natural flowering of prayer and learning. When we encounter the Light, we are called to reflect it outward—to bring warmth and hope to those who dwell in darkness. Every act of charity, forgiveness, and justice becomes an Advent candle shining in the world.

This Advent 2025, let us unite these three pillars into one living response: to *act* upon our spiritual gifts and charisms, letting God's grace flow through us. We are not meant to be passive spectators of the Incarnation, but active participants in it—bearing the Light of Christ into the places where it is most needed.

May this season awaken in us a renewed desire to pray deeply, to learn faithfully, and to serve generously. And as we journey toward Christmas, may we, like Saint Katharine Drexel, become radiant reflections of the One who is the Light of the World. Come, Lord Jesus, Light of Life. Kindle in us the fire of your love.

Couples will also prepare the wedding liturgy with the parish's Director of Music and provide updated sacramental certificates and necessary documents as required by the Diocese of Venice. 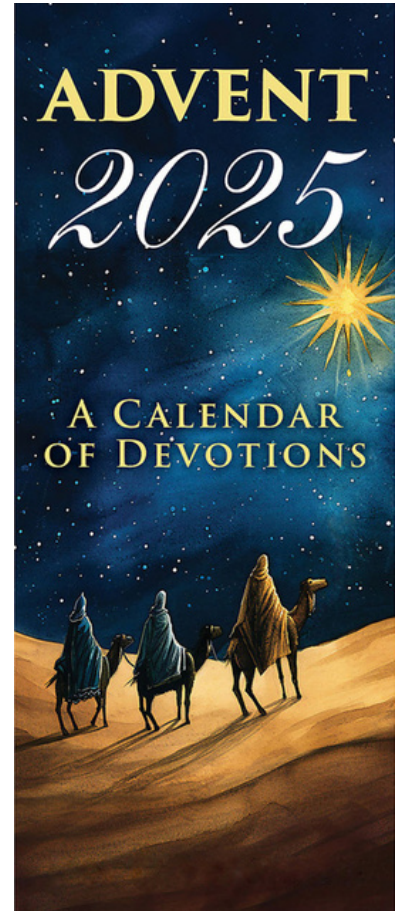

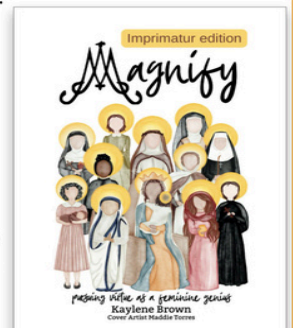
