HEARING LOOP LISTENING SYSTEM

Our parish is pleased to offer a Hearing Loop Assistive Listening System to better serve all who gather for worship and to support fuller participation in the sacred liturgy. This advanced technology transmits sound directly to hearing aids and cochlear implants equipped with a telecoil (T-coil), providing clearer, more personalized audio by significantly reducing background noise, echo, and reverberation within the church. By enhancing speech clarity, the hearing loop allows parishioners to more easily follow prayers, Scripture readings, and the homily.

To use the system, please switch your hearing aid or cochlear implant to the T (Telecoil) setting, or use your device's loop or assistive listening program if available.

Dear SKD Families,

Christ is risen! Alleluia!

Easter morning begins in quiet sorrow. In the Gospel of Matthew, the women go to the tomb carrying grief and uncertainty. How close that feels to many of our own journeys. Yet there, in the place of death, they hear the words that change everything: "He is not here, for he has been raised." And then, so tenderly, Jesus meets them and says, "Do not be afraid." Fear gives way to joy. Darkness gives way to light.

In Acts, Peter simply tells the story: Jesus went about doing good, healing, loving, and serving. Though he was crucified, "God raised him on the third day." The Resurrection is God's great "yes" to hope. It is the promise that love is stronger than sin, mercy stronger than failure, and life stronger than death.

Saint Paul reminds us in Colossians, "If you were raised with Christ, seek what is above... For you have died, and your life is hidden with Christ in God." Easter is not only something we celebrate; it is something we live. In our homes, in our marriages, in our friendships, in the ordinary routines of family life – Christ is alive. When we forgive one another, when we begin again, when we pray together, when we choose patience and kindness, the Risen Lord is present among us.

To every family in our parish: whatever burdens you carry, whatever hopes you hold, know that the stone has been rolled away. Christ walks with you. He meets you in your joys and in your struggles. And he speaks to your heart the same words he spoke that first Easter morning: Do not be afraid.

May this holy season fill your home with peace, your hearts with renewed faith, and your lives with the deep and lasting joy of the Resurrection.

A blessed and joyful Easter to you all!

RE: Temporary Schedule Changes Due to Fire Sprinkler System Repairs

Peace be with you. I would like to inform you of temporary schedule changes due to necessary repairs to the church's fire sprinkler system and the replacement of the church roof. These changes will be in effect from April 20th through June 1st.

Church Building Closure (Monday–Friday):

The main church building will be closed during weekdays to allow for the safe and efficient completion of repairs and roof replacement.

Weekday Mass (Monday–Friday):

Weekday Mass @ 9:00 am will be celebrated in the parish hall. Wednesday Confessions will be held in the parish hall after Mass.

Weekend Masses (Saturday and Sunday):

All weekend Masses (and Confessions) will continue to be held in the church as usual.

Funerals (Monday–Friday):

Funeral services will take place in the parish hall.

Adoration Chapel:

The Adoration Chapel will be closed for the duration of the repairs.

Eucharistic Adoration:

Eucharistic Adoration will be held in the parish hall from 9:30 am to 12:00 Noon, Monday through Friday only.

FEED MY STARVING CHILDREN

FMSC MEALS SHIPPED TO HAITI, GUATEMALA AND ANGOLA

We recently learned where the meals packed at our February Feed My Starving Children MobilePack were shipped.

- **Haiti: 186,624** meals were shipped to **Love a Child** which is a non-profit Christian humanitarian organization, serving the needs of children in Haiti through schools, feeding programs, an orphanage and medical outreach. LAC distributes FMSC meals to its schools, remote communities and more than 60 missionary organizations in-country. What's really interesting is Love a Child is based in Fort Myers and is one of the early and most loved partners FMSC works with. Check them out at <https://loveachild.com/>
- **Angola: 31,104** meals were shipped to **ForAfrika** which is Africa's largest indigenous humanitarian organization, committed to creating food security and stable livelihoods for vulnerable communities. Their mission is to provide emergency food response, healthcare, education, and economic opportunities that empower people to thrive. Check them out at <http://www.forafrika.org>

- **Guatemala: 15,552** meals were shipped to **Food for the Poor** who links the church of the First World with the church of the Third World in a manner that helps both the materially poor and the poor in spirit. FFTP has distributed FMSC meals for many years through its extensive network of partner organizations in the Caribbean, Central America and South America. 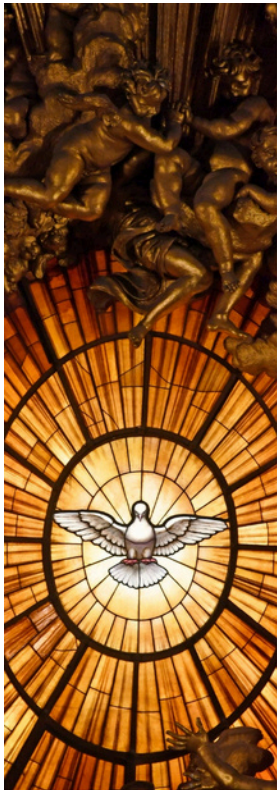

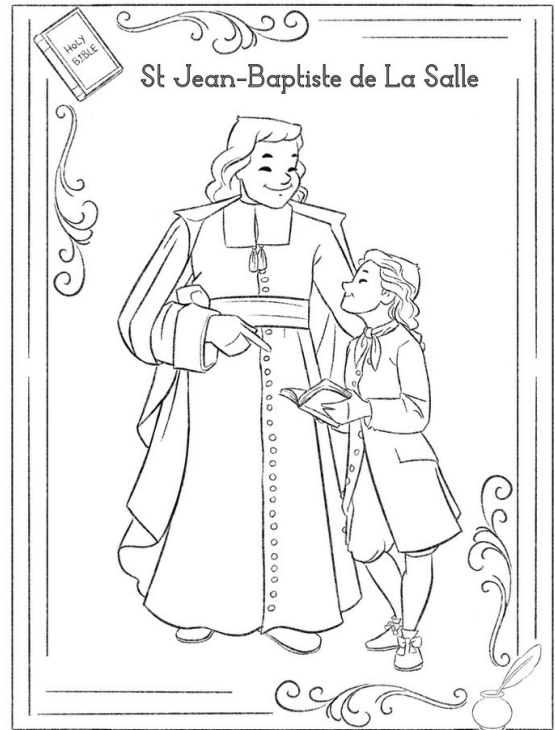
