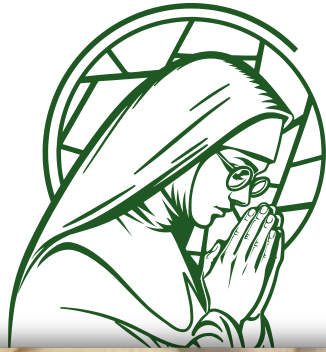

If you're new to our parish or have been attending Mass without registering, we kindly ask you to register to help us stay organized and plan for future needs. If you haven't received a welcome letter, please call the parish office to confirm your registration.

Registering at Saint Katharine Drexel expresses your commitment to our Catholic community.

Often, those seeking to celebrate sacraments or serve as sponsors need a letter confirming parish membership. To receive one, you must be registered, attend Mass regularly, and actively support the parish through time, talent, and treasure. Using parish offertory envelopes, even if empty, helps track participation. If you're unable to contribute treasure now, simply placing an empty envelope in the basket still shows your presence and support.

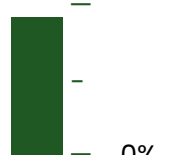

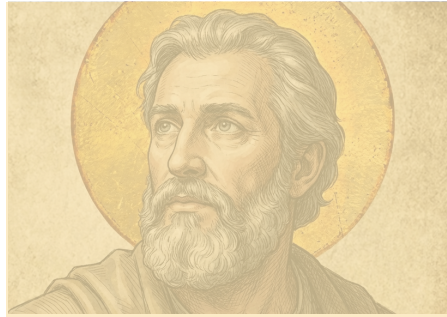

SAINT EPHREM

SAINT OF THE WEEK

He was born in present-day Turkey, the son of a pagan priest and a Christian mother. From a very young age, he displayed an explosive temper, which he learned to control. At a very young age, he was baptized and later ordained a deacon. His ministry was dedicated to teaching the faith, for he was a great teacher. His bishop, noting his Christian and human qualities, wanted to ordain him a priest, but Ephrem opposed it, considering the priesthood unworthy of him. As a deacon and teacher, he spread Christian teaching with extraordinary writing skills, making use of poetry, religious songs, and parodying the lyrics of popular songs of his time to not only refute Christian heresies but also to propagate the teachings of Christ.

History distinguishes him with the nickname "The Zither of the Holy Spirit." Through his poetry, he founded a theological school. Although he did not speak Greek, he was bold in his language, writing poems dedicated to Mary, Mother of God. His writings and mysticism made him one of the Doctors of the Church.

TREASURES FROM OUR TRADITION

ORDINARY TIME BECKONS, AND SO ON THIS SUNDAY WE SURRENDER THE LAST GLIMMERS OF PASCHAL JOY AS WE CELEBRATE THE RENEWAL OF OUR LIFE AROUND THE TABLE OF THE EUCHARIST. THIS FEAST REMINDS US THAT THE GOAL OF THE CATECHUMEN'S JOURNEY THROUGH LENT IS NOT THE BAPTISMAL FONT AT EASTER, BUT RATHER THE EXPERIENCE OF PENTECOST. IT IS ALL ABOUT LIFE LIVED IN THE SPIRIT'S EMBRACE IN RELATIONSHIP TO THE BODY OF CHRIST, WHICH IS FOUND BOTH "ON THE TABLE" AND "AT THE TABLE."

THE SEASON OF CONFIRMATION IS ALSO DRAWING TO A CLOSE, AND THIS FEAST SERVES AS A REMINDER THAT THIS SACRAMENT, A SOLEMN SENDING FROM FONT TO TABLE, IS KEYED TO RENEWED VIGOR. CONFIRMATION HAS SOMETIMES BEEN SADLY MISUNDERSTOOD AS A KIND OF GRADUATION FROM RELIGIOUS FORMATION, BUT IT IS NOTHING OF THE SORT. IT IS ABOUT BEING LED BY THE LORD JESUS TO THE PLACE WHERE THE SPIRIT FLOURISHES, AND WHERE THE GIFTS OF THE SPIRIT ARE MOST EASILY DETECTABLE. AFTER NEXT WEEK WE WILL RESUME OUR CONSIDERATION OF THE SACRAMENT OF CONFIRMATION, ITS RICH AND SOMEWHAT TANGLED HISTORY, ITS CHALLENGING THEOLOGY, AND ITS CHANGING CELEBRATION.



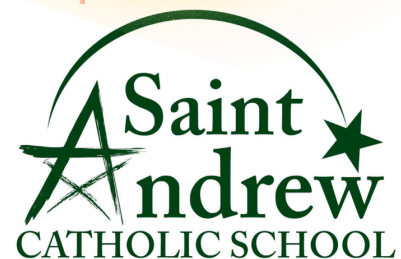


