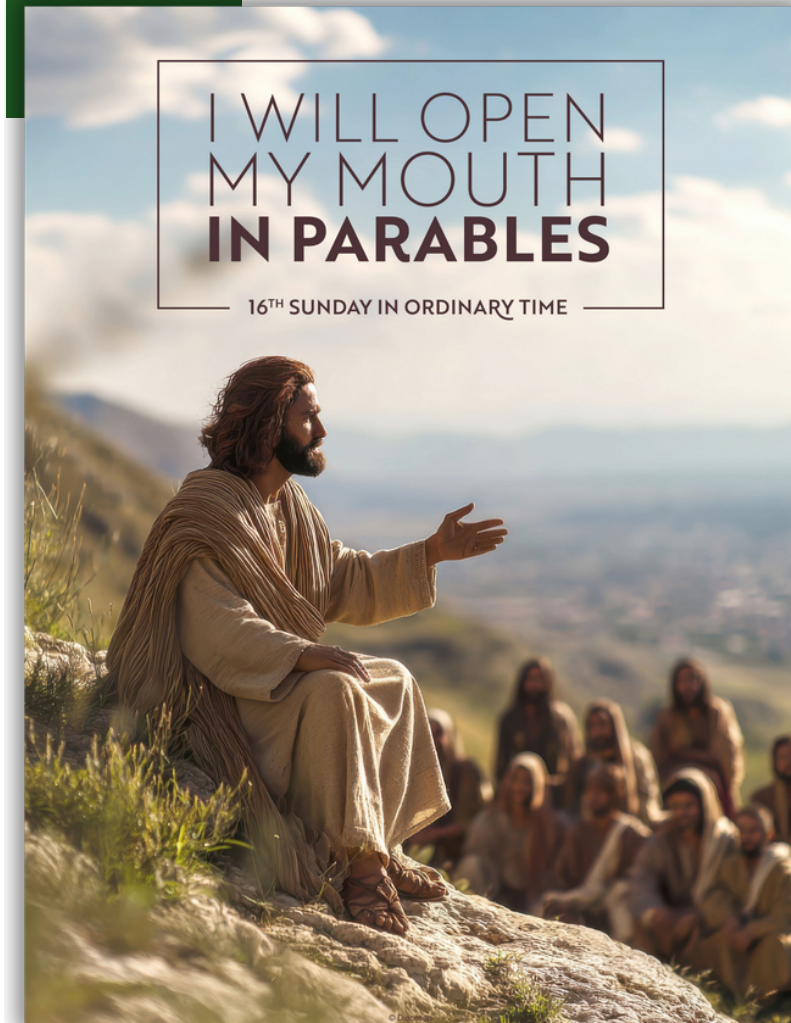

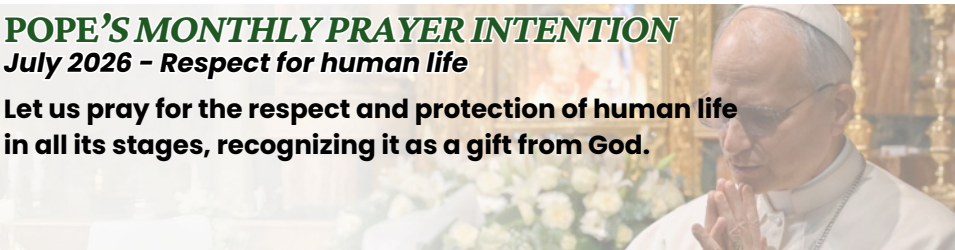

SAINT OF THE WEEK

Saint Mary Magdalene

Though her transgressions may have been many, just as abundant was her love for her Lord. Perhaps one of the greatest conversion stories of the New Testament, Mary Magdalene was one from whom seven demons had been expelled, a woman plagued by turmoil. She lived her own type of hell on earth, that is, until Jesus crossed her path one day. She first appears in the Bible accompanying him as he journeyed from one town to the other “preaching and proclaiming the good news of the kingdom of God”. Her gratitude led her to follow and serve her Lord tirelessly, all the way up to the foot of the cross. She did not abandon him in the face of difficulty, nor did she deny him despite the harsh cruelty all around her. She was one of the few to accompany him, gazing upon his beaten and torn countenance as he took his final breath. Jesus rewarded this loving devotion as she is known in Mark’s account to be the first one to see him after the Resurrection (Mark 16:9). May we follow the example of Saint Mary Magdalene in our unwavering dedication to God, so that at the end of our days we may also declare, “I have seen the Lord!”

TREASURES FROM OUR TRADITION

BY THE DAWN OF THE FOURTEENTH CENTURY, THE SACRAMENT OF CONFIRMATION WAS RIPE FOR A RESCUE, SINCE VAST NUMBERS OF THE FAITHFUL NEVER RECEIVED IT, AND WHEN IT WAS CELEBRATED, IT WAS DONE SO IN ISOLATION FROM BAPTISM AND EUCHARIST. A BISHOP NAMED WILLIAM DURANDUS SET OUT TO RECLAIM THIS LITURGY, BUT HE HAD A CREATIVE TOUCH AND ADDED SOME THINGS INTO THE MIX THAT HAD NEVER BEEN THOUGHT OF BEFORE. ONE WAS A SLAP. ODDLY, HE REPLACED THE KISS OF PEACE AT THE END OF CONFIRMATION WITH A SLAP ON THE CHEEK THAT ENDURED TO MODERN TIMES. THIS “WAKE-UP CALL” WAS RELATED IN HIS IMAGINATION TO A CUSTOM IN THE MILITARY, WHEREIN CEREMONIES OF KNIGHTHOOD AND INVESTITURE INVOLVED A SYMBOLIC WOUND AS A SIGN OF WILLINGNESS TO SUFFER.

WITHIN EVERY CONGREGATION TODAY THERE ARE PEOPLE WHO HAVE MEMORIES OF FRETTING THROUGH THEIR CONFIRMATION LITURGIES, ANXIOUS TO KNOW HOW ENTHUSIASTIC A SLAP THE BISHOP WOULD BESTOW. DURANDUS LOVED SYMBOLISM AND HAD A REASON FOR EVERY RITUAL AND PRACTICE, BUT HIS CREATIVE SPIN ON THE CELEBRATION SHOWS HOW SADLY ADRIFT CONFIRMATION WAS FROM ITS ANCHORAGE IN BAPTISM, HOW FAR OFF-COURSE FROM ITS HOME PORT OF THE EUCHARISTIC COMMUNITY.

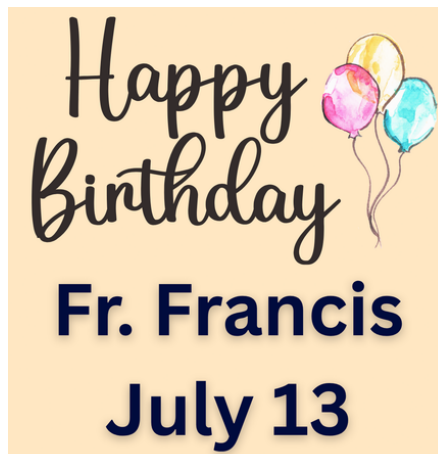

My Dear Brothers & Sisters in Christ,

On June 24, 2026, two consecutive earthquakes of 7.2 and 7.5 magnitudes struck northern Venezuela. In recent days, all of us have seen heart wrenching images and videos of the damage and human toll of this disaster. These pictures show us parents searching for missing children, rescue teams digging through rubble, and everywhere people picking up the pieces.

These "doublet" earthquakes have caused grave and extensive devastation throughout the region, with over 2,000 confirmed deaths and thousands missing at this time. Further, there are many thousands of individuals who have been injured, and countless homes and other buildings have been damaged and destroyed.

Our Lord calls each of us to care for our brothers and sisters in need, and, at this time in particular, for those who are suffering in the wake of this terrible tragedy. Recognizing the need of those who have been so severely impacted by the earthquakes as well as to inquiries regarding the Diocese's response, a second collection will be held throughout the Diocese of Venice on the weekend of July 25-26, which will be sent to assist in recovery.

Your generosity for the people of Venezuela is deeply appreciated. Regardless of your generous response of assistance, please continue to pray for all who are suffering as a result of this terrible disaster, as well as for those who have lost their lives.

I take this opportunity to extend to you the assurances of my continued consideration, as well as my prayers.
